Horse Health Declaration Forms:

These forms are to be filled out and handed in on your arrival at our show; please do not send this form in with your nominations, stabling camping etc. These forms are to assure us that your horse, to the best of your knowledge, is fit and well and showing no signs of sickness, therefore you must hand them in on your arrival. Forms are available at the office, or you can download at <http://www.qld.equestrian.org.au>, go to documents and forms, scroll down, and click on Horse, scroll down to EQ Health Declaration.

Gate Passes:

- All horse exhibitors will receive one gate pass for the exhibitor's use only and must be collected prior to the event.
- Additional passes must be purchased prior to the event. Prices for 2-day gate passes are Adult \$25 and Children/Pensioners \$15.

Conditions of Entry:

- Refer General Conditions & Show Rules.
- PIC# QIAE0505
- Exhibitors must be 5 years or older to participate in led pony classes. (Subject to competency requirements being satisfied at any age at the chief stewards discretion which will be the final decision.)
- Times, sequence of events and rings maybe varied at the discretion of the Ring Stewards who may cancel any entry or event deemed necessary.
- Float/camp size must be specified on camping application form. Once all applications are received allocations will be made.
- **No vehicles and/or floats will be permitted on grounds without prior approval.**
- Camping sites must be booked on the correct form and paid in advance and no vehicle will be permitted on grounds for camping until all fees have been paid.
- A camping area with limited power, toilets and open stalls is available on Vernon Street which is within 300 meters from the show grounds.
- **The Show Grounds are dog free and campers with dogs must use the camping area on Vernon Street.**
- Any dogs that are not assistance/guide dogs or competition dogs found on the Show Grounds will be removed by local laws and any fees for recovery of the animal/s will be the owner's responsibility.
- Horse stalls must be booked on the correct form and paid for in advance.
- Stalls are **not** provided for non-competitive horses and are only available for horses competing over the 2 days.
- Parking will be controlled by the Stewards. Vehicles and trailers will not be permitted in the vicinity of the unloading area or ramp unless unloading.
- Vehicles & trailers transporting horses to the Show will be permitted to enter the grounds to unload only. The vehicle &/or trailer must be removed from the grounds immediately once unloading is completed.
- All animals in the Section must be bona fide property of the Exhibitor 30 days prior to show and he or she shall make affidavit that the exhibit is his or her property.
- Competitors will be called three (3) times for events then disqualified if not at the starting point.
- Dress of Jumping Competitors: the following will constitute compulsory dress: EA approved helmet with harness, white shirt, white or cream jodhpurs, long black or brown boots and coat. Winter Competition Season in denoted as 1st May through 1st October and wearing of a coat is compulsory between these dates. It will be noted that under extreme weather conditions, the judge of the event can nominate as to whether a coat is worn, shirt with tie is compulsory, together with white or cream jodhpurs.
- Stallions cannot compete in Hack classes.
- Pony is under 14 hands. Galloway must be 14 hands and over, but not exceeding 15 hands.
- A maiden hack is a hack that has not won a hack class competition at an affiliated show. After winning a maiden hack class this horse will be recognised as Novice.
- The total weight of rider and accessories must not exceed 20% of the weight of the horse. The judge's decision regarding the condition of entry will be final.
- Breed Registration Certificates must be available for inspection by Stewards.

- Breed, name of horse, sex and correct class must be clearly printed on the Entry Form together with name and age (where required) and postal address of exhibitor.
- **Local means within the defined area of Mareeba, Atherton, Herberton, Ravenshoe and Malanda. Horse to have been in the defined local area for not less than twelve (12) weeks prior to the show date. District to mean within the area of Mackay north & west to Mt Isa.**
- All horse entries must be made on Society's nomination form and duly signed by the owner. Each horse must be nominated in one owner's name only throughout the program.
- All events will be judged under EA rules. All jumping horses in graded 1.05m and above events must be registered. All horses shall be liable to measurements at the discretion of the judge or Ring Steward.
- The rider must present Identification to collect Prize money.
- Scratchings: No refund will be made unless under extreme circumstances.
- The competitor's age must be shown on the Entry Form, where required. Competitors competing in events with age groups will be required to provide proof of age. All riders competing in jumping events shall be tried over jumps as the judge directs.
- Doping: refer to General Conditions.
- Competitors may take part in competitions and Championships for Junior from the beginning of the year they reach the age of 12 until the end of the calendar year they reach 18.
- Competitors may take part in competitions and Championships for Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year when they reach the age of 16 until they reach the age of 21.
- From the beginning of the year in which they reach the age of 16, competitors may, if the Organizers so stipulate, compete in both Junior and Senior fixtures provided the same horse does not compete in both Junior and Senior Classes at the same fixture. Horses competing in Junior Classes at this show may not compete in graded events.
- All entire horses permitted to use an alternative to a bit and bar, a properly fitted stallion chain to be made of quarter inch welded links to be 80cm long and attached to a strongly constructed halter.
- Should three or more entries of any Breed not specified be entered by different owners, a special class will be provided.
- Definitions: Colt - under 3 years; Stallion - 3 years and over; filly - under 3 years; Mare - 3 years and over. Miniatures accepted.
- Ring Stewards reserve the right to order the removal of any horse which they consider is not under complete control of the handler or which is disrupting another horse.

Stables and Camping

- First Round Applications **OPEN 1st – 31st May 2025** and stalls will be allocated after 1st June.
- Final applications close on 21st June.
- **Camp sites and stables are not secure unless confirmed by the show office and the invoice paid in full.**
- Confirm your booking with the Show Office **before** entering the grounds.
- Due to unpaid fees in the past, the grounds will be open during certain times for fully paid camping competitors to enter and set up and these times will be advised to those campers only with stewards available to direct.
- All non-camping competitors must contact the office to obtain a vehicle pass and may only enter the grounds once all paying competitors are on grounds.
- Due to the limited camp space and stables available please consider the size of your vehicle and trailer and the number of horses you intend on bringing to our event.
- Stables are only available for horses competing and if you require additional space, we suggest booking a site on the recreational grounds.
- When entering the Show grounds please consider where your site is and make allowances for all others who may need access to sites surrounding.
- Competitors with outstanding camping and/or stabling fees will not be permitted to compete until all fees are paid.
- The stable/s and camp site you request may not be available when you submit your application, please confirm all bookings **before** entering the grounds.
- Grey water must be disposed of appropriately and not within the Show Grounds.

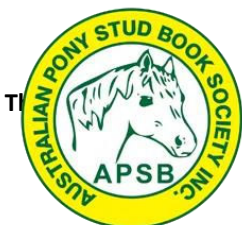
