- Pot Plants must be homegrown at least 3 months prior to Show.
- Pot Plants can be a basket. Either can be hanging.
- Pots and baskets must be clean.
- Pot diameter maximum 25cm and basket diameter maximum 30cm.
- Pots or baskets are 3kg maximum. Plastic pots and plastic or wire baskets are preferred.
- AOV means Any Other Variety.

- Ornamental vases, pots, or bowls are the responsibility of the Exhibitor.
- AOV means Any Other Variety.
