- Please print your NAME & ADDRESS WITH CLASS clearly marked on back of exhibit.
- Class Cards are to be clearly displayed on the front of exhibits
- Print size-Seniors: maximum 30cm x 20cm (12" x 8"), minimum 20cm x 15cm (8" x 6").
- Print size-Juniors: maximum 30cm x 20cm (12" x 8"), minimum 10cm x 15cm (4" x 6").
- Mounting size: all entries to be suitably mounted on any colour cardboard backing larger than the print; at least 2.5cm, but no more than 5cm each side. Framed prints will not be accepted. Window mounted matt are acceptable.
- Please note that the presentation of your photo may enhance your chance of winning.
- All entries must be provided on photographic paper, regardless of whether professional or amateur printing is used.
- Please advise the Show Office or the Stewards of any entries entered but not delivered for judging.
- Entries open to Far North Queensland amateurs only. An amateur is defined as someone who does not earn a full living from photography.
- No exhibit will be offered for sale during show.
- Stewards reserve the right to decide the suitability of photos for exhibit.
- Exhibits not collected within 3 months of the Show, will become the property of the Show Society.
- Exhibits may not be taken until after 4pm on the last day of Show, and then only under Steward's supervision.
