Workshop & Demonstration Information (Terms & Conditions)

Atherton Show – Monday 29th & Tuesday 30th June 2026

AGREEMENT

- By submitting an application to run a workshop or demonstration at the Atherton Show, the applicant agrees to these Terms & Conditions. Once accepted, these terms form a binding agreement between the applicant and the Atherton Tableland Agricultural Society.

CONFIRMATION & PAYMENT

- Please provide dimensions of the space required and preferred area on your Indication of Interest Form.
- Indoor space is 6m x 3m.
- Outdoor space can vary in size.
- Allocations **will be made by the Atherton Tableland Agricultural Society (“Society”)**, and the decision will be **final**.
- You will be **notified** when **your workshop or demonstration is confirmed**.
- A 20-minute loading zone is available on Mazlin Street from Sunday before Show until the end of Show Tuesday.

PASSES

- Two x 2-day Trade passes are provided FREE per workshop / demonstration for the Atherton Show.
- A limited number of extra trade passes are available prior to the Show for fifteen dollars (\$15) each.
- It is the responsibility of the person running the workshop / demonstration to **collect** trade passes at the **Show Office prior to the Show**.
- Trade Passes will **not be available at the gate**. Full show entry price will be charged for gate entry to those who have not collected their passes.

TIMES

- Times are allocated by the Show Society and are final.
- Please designate your setup and pack-up time in the length of your workshop / presentation.
- All workshops and demonstrations must operate **to the full approved schedule**.
- Presenters must be set up and ready to commence **at the published start time**.

ELECTRICITY

- Power is limited and requirements must be noted in your Indication of Interest Form.
- 10amp supply is standard across all areas, with some sites offering 15amp and 3-phase power.
- **Leads are required and must not** cross doorways, walkways, or roads unless safely concealed with prior approval.
- You are required to **ensure** that **equipment, electrical leads, tools, and appliances** have been inspected and **compliantly tagged** by a **suitably qualified individual**. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public, and is required by the current Electrical Safety Regulations.
- The use of **double adaptors** is **prohibited**, and all **power boards** must be **tested and tagged**.

SETUP & RESOURCES

- While preferences may be requested, allocation is subject to operational needs.
- All activities, equipment, and participants must remain within the allocated space.
- **Tables and chairs** are available if indicated. Allocations will be made by the Society, and the decision will be final.
- **Water** is available if indicated.

INSURANCE

- It is necessary for any person renting a site on the Showgrounds **to show proof** of their **Public Liability Insurance**. A **valid Certificate of Currency** must be provided with the Trade Site Application Form prior to site being confirmed.
- Atherton Tableland Agricultural Society (or "all QAS affiliated Shows") must be shown as an Interested Party on your Insurance Policy.
- If you do not hold current Public Liability Insurance, short-term Market Stallholder's Insurance is available online.

SAFETY & CONDUCT

- Workshops and demonstrations must be conducted in a **safe, professional, and family-friendly manner**.
- The use of equipment, tools, sound systems, or materials must not interfere with other participants or the public.
- The Show Society reserves the right to stop any activity considered unsafe or inappropriate.

RESPONSIBILITY & LIABILITY

- The Show Society is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to equipment or personal property.
- Presenters are responsible for supervising their equipment, materials, and participants at all times.

GENERAL CONDITION

- Sub-letting or transferring workshop space is not permitted without written approval.
- Glass, smoking, vaping, and e-cigarettes are prohibited on the showgrounds.
- Dogs are prohibited on the showgrounds (registered assistance dogs permitted).
- All presenters and assistants must behave in an orderly and respectful manner.
- The Society **reserves the right to refuse or cancel** any workshop or demonstration, change site location or schedule if required for operational or safety reasons
- No advertising, canvassing, hawking or distribution of printed material is permitted outside of your designated area.
