STABLES & CAMPING TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Camp sites and stables are not secured unless confirmed by the Show Office and invoice paid in full.
- Due to unpaid fees in the past, the grounds will be open during certain times for fully paid campers to enter and set up and these times will be advised to those campers only.
- All non-camping competitors must contact the Show Office to obtain a vehicle pass and may only enter the grounds once all paying competitors are on grounds.
- **NO DOGS** are permitted on the grounds. All dogs will be removed by Local Laws and impounded.

Vaccination

- All horses attending or competing at any time must complete the QAS Horse Health Declaration/ Movement form and submit immediately upon arrival at the showgrounds.
- Applications for campsites and/or stalls will not be accepted without documentation of current Vaccinations.

Camping Sites

- A limited number of camping sites are available, with preference given to travelling exhibitors.
- Applications must be made on the correct form and paid in advance.
- Please indicate the total length and width on the form.
- Sites may be allocated as exhibitors arrive on the day, and the Atherton Show Society will have the final decision on site allocation. If you setup in a site not allocated to you, you will be asked to move.
- Please remember our stewards are **volunteers** and are here to always ensure the safety of all.
- The camping fee covers two nights. Extra nights available.

Horse Stalls

- **A limited number of stables are available, with preference given to travelling horses.**
- Applications must be made on the correct form and paid in advance.
- While every effort will be made to grant the preferred stall(s), the allocations will be made by the Atherton Show Society, and the decision will be final.
- The number of stalls requested may not be granted.
- Stalls are not provided for non-competitive horses, and preference given to horses competing on both days.
- Cancellations must be received by 5pm Sunday, 7 days before the Show for a refund.

Terms of Application

- No vehicle movement on the showgrounds during Show Days between 8:45am and 10pm on Monday, and 8:45am and 4pm on Tuesday. Please arrange to deliver any feed or other supplies outside of these hours.
- Applicants/Exhibitors must agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and acknowledge that any misconduct or refusal to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the immediate removal of the applicant/exhibitor and their horse(s) no matter where that may occur.
- By signing this application, you are agreeing to indemnify the Atherton Tableland Agricultural Society Inc, against Liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness caused to anyone, including but not limited to the applicant/exhibitor or their property, or a member of the public during any part of the event, including but not limited to stabling, camping, preparation, competition, judging, performing or displaying.
- The Atherton Showgrounds are glass, smoke, vape & E-cigarette free during the event from 9am Show Monday to 4pm Show Tuesday.
- There are NO designated smoking areas on the Showgrounds, and all smoking must occur outside the fence.
- QLD Health may have representatives present and on the spot fines may be issued for non-compliance.

Gate Passes

- Competitors will be issued a competitors pass, which must be collected from the Show Office before 4pm on Sunday 28th June.
- All other persons occupying a camp site must pre-purchase their passes before 4pm on Sunday 28th June or will be required to purchase tickets at 1-day gate prices.
- Prices for 1-day passes purchased at the gate are Adult \$30 and Child(school-aged)/Pensioner \$15.
